

The Tradition Begins...

1876 was the year Camillus Cutlery Company came into being, when an immigrant from Germany set himself up in the imported hardware and cutlery business in New York City.



Circa early 1900s

Business prospered until protective tariffs late in the 19th Century made imports too costly and a domestic source of good cutlery had to be found if the business was to survive.

The founder, Adolph Kastor located such a supplier at a small knife factory in Camillus, N.Y., and purchased the factory outright. Mr. Kastor began producing knives, and the village of Camillus saw a modern industrial enterprise take form, creating employment and contributing wealth to the community.

The First Century

World War I tremendously stepped up production as the U.S. and allied governments ordered Navy and Army knives as well as surgical scalpels. The first orders for the war effort came from the Canadian Government in 1914 - the marlin spike knives for use by the British and Canadian Navies.

When WWII began, over one half of Camillus production was required to feed the U.S. war machines. By October of 1942, 90% of the products produced were for the government. Over 13,000,000 knives were sent to Uncle Sam's forces. Camillus Cutlery proudly accepted the coveted Army and Navy "E" Award not once, but three times, for its excellence in manufacturing and dedication to the war effort.

With more than 120 years of cutlery manufacturing experience, the craftsmen and craftswomen at Camillus are committed to constant research into the efficiency of knife design and the development of improved cutlery performance.

At the heart of any knife is the steel used in the blade. These blades are made with such precision that "if a person were to bake a cake with the same relative care, their measurements would be in the ten thousandths of an ounce." During our manufacturing process, the basic steel is tempered, treated and passes through constant metallurgical analysis.

Our facilities are the most modern for the manufacture of cutlery. Modern machines and methods, combined with highly skilled workmanship and engineering, have made it not only one of the largest mass producers of knives, but also the producers of the very finest quality knives.

Quality Manufacturing Excellence

No matter how superior the basic materials, any knife is only as good as the "craftspeople" that made it. Generations of employees have grown up in a tradition of cutlery excellence and their skills have been passed on through the constant training of new apprentices. As a result, the Camillus work force is not only skilled in their craft, but also has pride in the knives they manufacture.

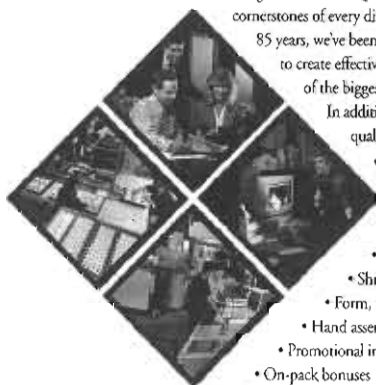
