The spear point blade is 2" long, 3/8" wide, double hollow ground to a razor-sharp edge and then equipped with aggressive serrations for cutting in a wide range of materials. Plus, at just

1.3 oz. it's ultra-light!

It's the knife of choice in our shipping department for ripping open heavy cartons and it zips through thick carpet and nylon rope. Scuba divers are using it, and it's become a favorite among fishermen in Alaska for cutting nets and heavy line.

High Performance Knives

Performance

Good looks are important, in knives as much as in life! Perfect fits, clean lines, precise grinds and beautiful polishes all add value and satisfaction when you buy a knife. But often the true beauty of a knife only becomes apparent when the knife is used! Solid, dependable performance will give years of faithful service and happy memories long after the "newness" is gone. At Cold Steel, we believe that all our knives must perform. That means from the smallest and least expensive to the finest and most expensive. Every one must deliver extraordinary performance for their asking price. In other words, they must deliver "more than their money's worth".

In order to achieve this goal, we are vitally interested in all the

elements that are critical to performance.

When it comes to the blade, these include profile, thickness, blade geometry, edge geometry, steel and heat treatment. Every one of these factors is studied in great detail to arrive at the optimum combination for a specific use. If the knife is a folder, we concentrate on the locking mechanism to ensure the strongest, safest construction. For handles, we strive to develop the perfect mix of materials and ergonomics to offer the most comfortable secure grip available. And, above all, we TEST what we make! Rigorous testing is the only way to ensure we get the level of performance we demand. Some of these tests are shown here (right).

The Finest Steel

400 Series Stainless

The words "stainless steel" are misleading, because, in fact all steel will stain or show discoloration if left in adverse conditions for a sufficient time. Steel is made "stainless" by adding Chromium and reducing its Carbon content during the smelting process. There is a serious performance trade-off with stainless steel: As the Chromium increases and the Carbon decreases, the steel becomes more "stainless". But it also becomes more and more difficult to sharpen, and the edge-holding potential is seriously impaired. This is usually why most stainless knives are rarely razor-sharp and quickly lose the little edge they have. In contrast, at Cold Steel we use a premium stainless steel with more carbon and less chrome content for everything from the Tanto to our new kitchen knives. We call it 400 Series stainless. It has all the strength and sharpness we are famous for, while it still remains very resistant to rust and corrosion and requires minimal care.

San Mai III™

An expensive, traditional style Japanese laminate. Hard, high carbon stainless forms the core and edge of the blade, while two layers of tough, spring tempered stainless support and strengthen it. The resulting blade possesses the best qualities of both steels. This laminate is 25% stronger than the incredibly tough 400 Series stainless in the original Tanto. The tell-tale sign of genuine San Mai III™ is a thin line near the edge that runs the entire length of the blade. This line is created in the grinding process as the layers of steel in the blade are exposed. The distance the line is from the edge varies from knife to knife because every piece of San Mai III™ steel is unique.

Carbon V®

An exclusive carbon alloy steel, formulated and extensively treated to achieve exceptional properties. We order large quantities of this steel, with small amounts of elemental alloys added in the smelting stage. These elements enhance the blade's performance in edge holding and elasticity. The steel is then rolled to our exact specifications to establish optimum grain refinement and blades are blanked to take full advantage of the grain direction in the steel. The final stage of production is a lengthy and very exact heat treatment sequence which results in blades which duplicate and often exceed the properties of the most expensive custom forgings.

Cold Steel Performance Testing

Tests of Strength



1 The Carbon V® Trailmaster Bowie under extreme pressure at about 23° in a vise. This blade returned to true after over one hour in this position. Most knives shatter or permanently bend well before they reach this point.

2 Cutting wood cleanly and leaving a polished cut surface indicates superior sharpness. Retaining a fine edge while repeatedly cutting pine (wood) in this way indicates superior fine edge retention. We maximize this potential.

3 Hammering a knife into hard maple and then snapping it out sharply to the side is an extreme test of point strength. Virtually all other knives fail this test: bending or breaking at the tip. Cold Steel is undamaged.

4 Manila rope is very tough on a knife edge. Its exterior repels all but the sharpest edges while its interior is abrasive enough to dull even the finest custom knives. Edges that can repeatedly cut this rope will last indefinitely under normal field use.

5 The original Tanto penetrating a car door. Critics say that practically any knife can be hammered through a car door... but unlike other knives, the Tanto's point is remarkably unaffected by the ordeal.

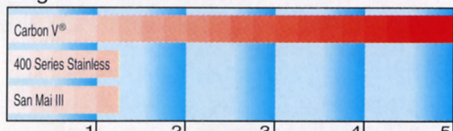
6 Shaving is a quick, easy indicator of sharpness. The cleaner and closer the shave, the sharper the knife. Most factory and custom knives are not this sharp. All Cold Steel knives will shave right out of the box!

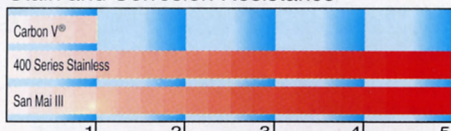


Relative Performance of our Premium Steels

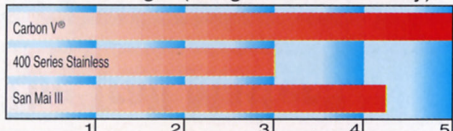
Edge Retention



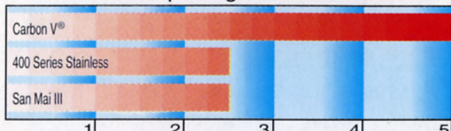

Most of the tests shown (above left) are dangerous and they should not be duplicated. The destructive tests shown here constitute gross abuse of a knife. Duplicating them will void your warranty.

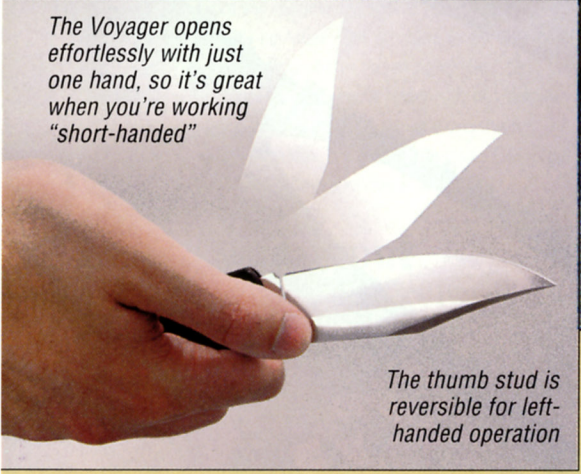

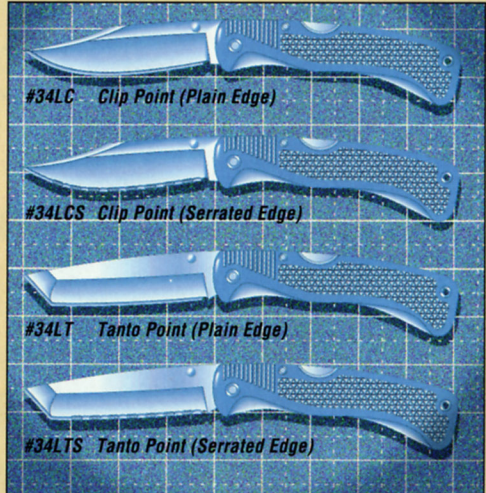

Every detail has been designed for performance, from the reinforced pivot pin, to the integral clip, to the grooved thumb shelf on the back of the knife for extra traction. The handle offers a superbly comfortable non-slip grip and it houses the blade in a sleek 3.3 ounce package that can be carried all day without effort. The Voyager's are ready to go anywhere and built to last a hard-working lifetime. And, best of all, they're affordable!

The lock itself, back spring and crucial pivot pin are all massively over-sized and hand fitted to perform as one unit of unparalleled strength.

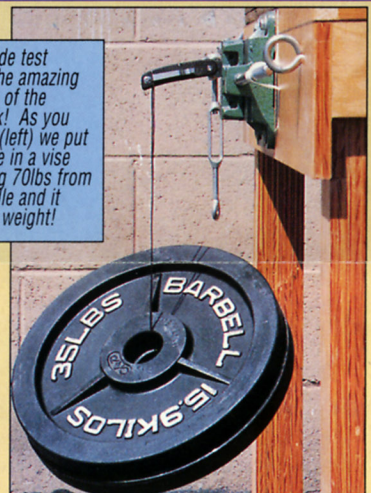

Under testing, the Ultralock has supported at least 75 lbs of pressure without collapsing (see picture above right). This is far more than you will ever exert during normal use, making the Ultralock significantly safer than most traditional lockbacks.

Another impressive feature of the Ultralock is the ease with which it can be opened. This is especially important in emergencies or when working "short-handed". If you've never been able to open a knife with one hand you'll love the Ultralock! It's so slick that you'll soon be amazing your friends with your skill at snapping the blade open. Lightweight yet heavy duty, the Ultralocks are razor-sharp and have a convenient stainless steel clip for easy carry on your belt or in your pocket. 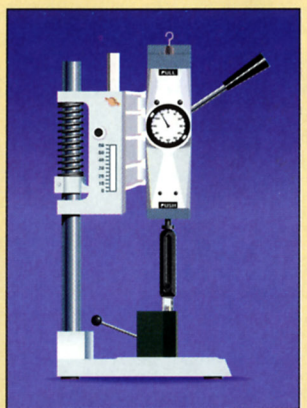
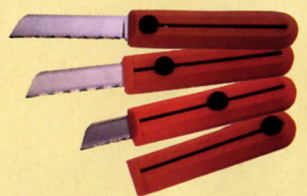

The broad clip point with false edge, is wider and thicker than typical bowies for maximum support and penetration, while the blade's continuous curve offers plenty of "belly" near the tip for skinning. Overall, the Trail Master® has ample length and weight for chopping, yet retains the balance needed for controlled cutting.

When you take hold of the comfortable Kraton® grip, feel the weight and balance and examine the superb fits and finishes you can sense the knife's potential. But you have to use it to fully appreciate its power. As the photos (below right) show, the Trail Master® can effortlessly sever manila hemp rope as thick as a man's arm. 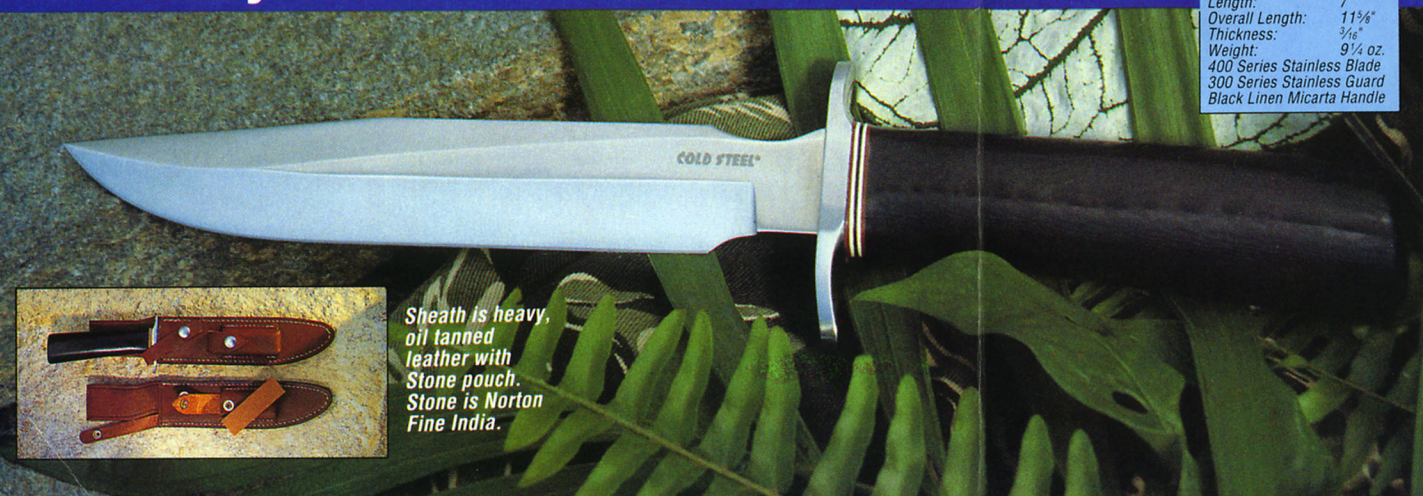
