POCKET-SIZE WESTLOCK KNIVES

NO. 521 BOBCAT— Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Satin finished 2½" drop point blade. Length closed 3¾". Complete with pocket pouch.



POCKET POUCH — Soft vinyl pouch protects knife and pocket.

NO. 522 PHEASANT— Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Satin finished 2½" regular clip blade. Length closed 3¾". Complete with pocket pouch.

MEDIUM-SIZE WESTLOCK KNIVES

NO. 532 WHITE TAIL DEER— Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Satin finished 3" drop point blade. Length closed 4¾". Molded leather belt sheath.



BELT SHEATH — Top-grain leather sheath with heavy duty snap. Full belt loop. Sheath slips on and off belt with ease.

NO. 534 BIG HORN SHEEP— Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Satin finished 3" clip blade. Length closed 4¾". Molded leather belt sheath.

LARGE-SIZE WESTLOCK KNIVES

NO. 541—Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Satin finish 3½" clip blade. Length closed 5". Molded leather sheath.



BELT SHEATH—Top-grain leather sheath with heavy duty snap. Embossed with basket weave pattern. Full-size belt loop on back of sheath. Standard color black. Also available in natural brown when specified.

NO. 542—Horn pattern Delrin handle. Satin finish 3½" clip blade. Length closed 5". Molded leather sheath.

WESTERN POCKET KNIVES

Knives shown 2/3 actual size

These knives are made by skilled craftsman using the finest of materials and will give many years of useful service. They have bolsters and shields of solid nickel silver and scales of solid brass. Springs are finished on the inside as well as the outside. Blades are made from special analysis cutlery steels, carefully heat-treated, mirror polished and hand honed to a keen edge.



NO. 062 FOLDING HUNTING KNIFE

— Always a popular knife because of the large blades, compactness when closed and the convenience of a second blade. Carbon steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Regular clip master blade and special long clip blade are both 3 1/2" long. Length closed 5 1/2". Molded leather belt sheath.



NO. 243 LANCE BLADE KNIFE — Carbon steel blades and springs. Pearl grey Delrin handle. Master clip blade, pen blade and surgical lance blade with exceptionally fine point. Length closed 2 1/4".



NO. 241 PEN KNIFE — Carbon steel blades and springs. Pearl grey Delrin handle. Master clip and pen blade. Knife is designed with blade in each end operated by a single spring to make it slim and light weight. Length closed 2 1/4".



NO. 244 LANCE BLADE KNIFE — Stainless steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Master clip blade, pen blade and surgical lance blade with exceptionally fine point. Length closed 2 1/4".



NO. 242 PEN KNIFE — Carbon steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Master clip and pen blade. Knife is designed with blade in each end operated by a single spring to make it slim and light weight. Length closed 2 1/4".



NO. 292 JACK KNIFE — Carbon steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Master clip blade and regular pen blade. Knife has traditional jack-knife blade action with square tangs on both blades to stop them in the half-open position. Length closed 2 1/4".





NO. 381 NAIL KNIFE — This traditional style is thin, light, easy to carry and made entirely of stainless steel. Satin finish handle. Master clip blade and nail file blade with cuticle point. Length closed 3".



NO. 652 LARGE PEN KNIFE — Carbon steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Knife is designed with blade at each end operated by a single spring to make it slim and light weight. Long clip master blade and pen blade. Length closed 3 3/8".



NO. 657 PUNCH BLADE STOCK KNIFE — A favorite because of its useful leather punch. Carbon steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Master clip blade, punch blade and spey blade. Length closed 3 3/8".



NO. 693 RACOONS — Stainless steel blade and spring. Split-scale type lock holds blade open when in use. Outdoor scene etched in blade. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Length closed 4 1/2".

NO. 693 W/S RACOONS — Above knife with leather belt sheath.



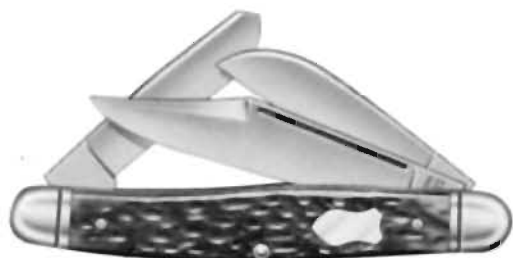
NO. 658 SMALL STOCK KNIFE — A scaled-down version of the premium stock knife. Carbon steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Master clip blade, sheepfoot blade and spey blade. Length closed 3 3/8".



NO. 6504 WOOD CRAFT KNIFE — Good for whittling or carpentry work. Carbon steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Master pocket blade, coping blade and small clip blade. Length closed 3 3/8".



NO. S-6504 WOOD CRAFT KNIFE — Good for whittling or carpentry work. Carbon stainless steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Master pocket blade, coping blade and small clip blade. Shield stamped "stainless." Length closed 3 3/8".



NO. 742 PREMIUM STOCK KNIFE — The "old standby" for anyone on a farm or ranch working with livestock. Carbon steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Master clip blade, sheepfoot blade and spey blade. Length closed 4".



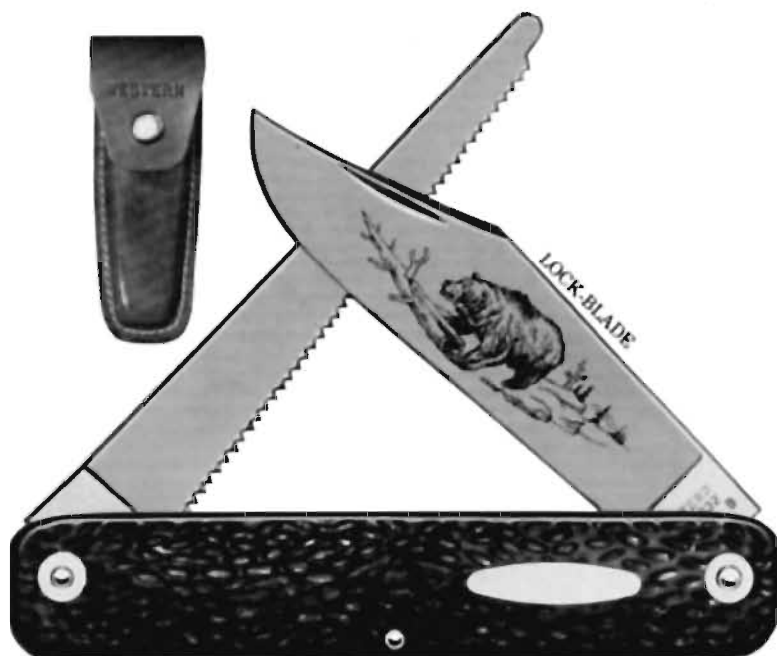
NO. 822 BARLOW KNIFE — Carbon steel blades and springs. Solid nickel-silver bolsters and brass scales. Saw pattern Delrin handle. Master clip blade and pen blade. Knife has traditional jack-knife blade action with square tangs on both blades to stop them in the half-open position. Length closed 3 3/4".



NO. 854 UTILITY KNIFE — Carbon steel blade and spring. Brown Delrin handle has hole for chain or thong. Flat ground 2 3/4" blade. Split-scale type lock holds blade open when in use. Blade has square tang. Length closed 4".



NO. 901 CAMPERS KNIFE — Five tools in one knife. General purpose master blade, leather punch, can opener and screwdriver with bottle-cap lifter. Stainless steel blades and springs. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Nickel silver bail. Length closed 3 3/4". Leather belt snap.



NO. 932 KNIFE-SAW, BEAR — A compact versatile tool modeled after a World War II pilot's survival knife. To reduce weight, knife is made with rosettes instead of the usual bolsters. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Carbon steel blades and springs. Flat ground 4 1/2" knife blade with split-scale type lock of heavy gauge brass. Outdoor scene etched on knife blade. Spring tempered 5" saw blade (10 teeth per inch). Each blade has a square tang and is operated by a separate spring. Length closed 6". Molded leather belt sheath.



WESTERN SHEATH KNIVES

These knives have been designed with a custom look that makes their quality obvious. Satin finish stainless steel blades, resin impregnated hardwood

handles, and rich top-grain leather sheaths are some of the badges of quality that make them truly outstanding.

NO. W 75 BOOT KNIFE—Unique design features one-piece blade and guard, full tang through handle, solid nickel silver rivets, and new design sheath (patent pending.) Double ground 3½" blade. Hardwood handle contoured to fit your hand. Overall length 7".



Spring clip on back of sheath.

NO. W77 BOOT KNIFE—Unique design features one-piece blade and guard, full tang through handle, solid nickel silver rivets, and new design sheath (patent pending). Double ground 4½" blade. Hardwood handle contoured to fit your hand. Overall length 8¾".

SHEATHS

Molded leather sheath has friction grip to hold knife in sheath and stainless steel spring clip on back. Thin sheath is comfortable to wear in your boot or on your belt. Convenient and easy to use.

NO. W83 DROP POINT KNIFE—Blade is 3¾" with high saber grind. Full tang and contoured hardwood handle grips. Solid brass rivets. Overall length 7¾". Holster type belt sheath.



NO. W84 DROP POINT KNIFE—Blade is 4¾" with high saber grind. Full tang and contoured hardwood handle grips. Solid brass rivets. Overall length 9". Holster type belt sheath.



WESTMARK Custom Quality SHEATH KNIVES

These handmade knives represent the ultimate in design, craftsmanship and materials. Made for rugged use, they have heavy gauge blades with double tangs, and handles with form-fitting contours. Each blade is stamped with an individual serial number. Leather scabbards are hand crafted from carefully selected 8 oz. hides, and made with triple thickness on the edges and heavy nylon stitching.

MODEL 701 — Designed with a high point and long, curved cutting edge. Stainless steel saber ground 5½" blade with satin finish. Laminated resin impregnated hardwood handle has brass guard and aluminum end-knob. Overall length 10".



MODEL 702 — General purpose knife with many uses. Narrow 5" blade of stainless steel has high saber grind and satin finish. Laminated resin impregnated hardwood handle has brass guard and aluminum end-knob. Overall length 9½".



MODEL 703 — Special shape has enlarged choil that enables user to place one finger ahead of guard for maximum control. Wide 4½" blade of stainless steel has high saber grind and satin finish. Laminated resin impregnated hardwood handle has brass guard and aluminum end-knob. Overall length 9".

These proven designs feature practical blade shapes, full length solid brass guards, well formed aluminum end-knobs and a variety of handle materials. They are built with Western's exclusive double-tang handle construction, except where noted. Blades are made from special analysis cutlery steels, carefully heat-treated, mirror polished and hand honed to a keen edge. Top-grain leather sheaths are made in the Western knife factory from vegetable-tanned hides.

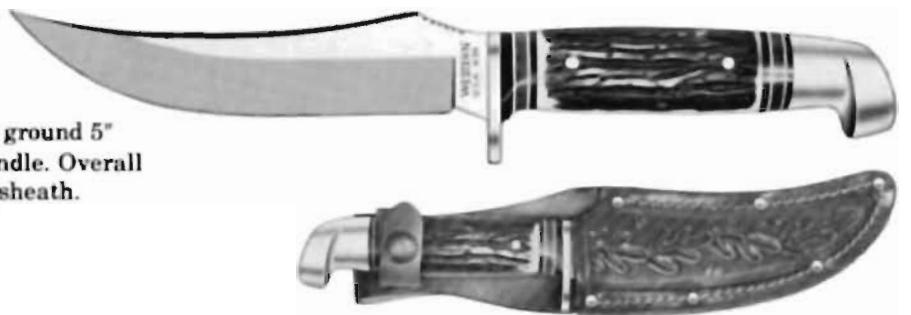
NO. 628—Carbon steel flat ground 3" blade. Stag pattern Delrin handle. Overall length 6". Embossed leather tubular sheath.

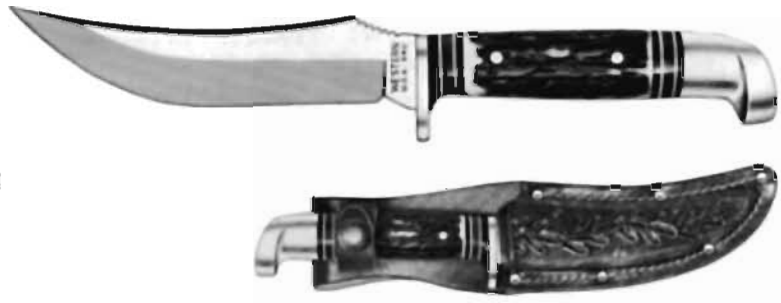
NO. H39—Carbon steel saber ground 5" blade. Horn pattern Delrin handle. Overall length 9¼". Embossed leather sheath.



NO. W39—Carbon steel saber ground 5" blade. Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Overall length 9¼". Embossed leather sheath.



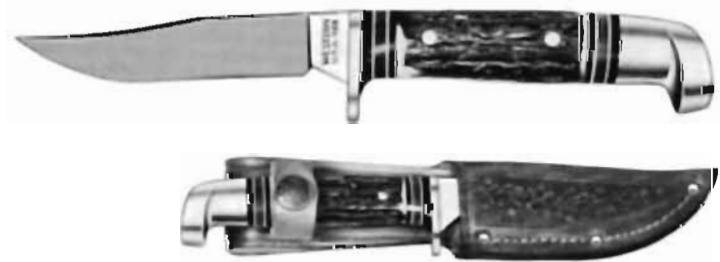

NO. L66—Carbon steel saber ground $4\frac{1}{2}$ " blade. Leather handle. Because of special qualities of leather, this knife is made in single tang only. Overall length $8\frac{1}{2}$ ". Molded leather sheath.



NO. W66—Carbon steel saber ground $4\frac{1}{2}$ " blade. Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Overall length $8\frac{1}{2}$ ". Molded leather sheath.



NO. W46-8 HEAVY DUTY SURVIVAL KNIFE Modern version of a survival knife made by Western during World War II for the Seabees and Marine Corps. Carbon steel, saber ground, heavy gauge, 8" blade with wide groove. Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Heavy brass double guard. Overall length 13". Special design, molded leather sheath.



FISH FILLET KNIVES

The premier fillet knife in use today! These knives feature a full-size handle which is shaped to provide a more secure grip and better control of the blade. Resin impregnated hardwood handle has brass rivets. Wide steel tang extends into handle.



NO. W764 FISH-CAMP KNIFE—A multi-purpose knife practical for both fishing and camping. Satin finished stainless steel flat ground 4½" blade. Overall length 9". Molded leather sheath.



NO. W766 FISH FILLET KNIFE—Thin, flexible blade fillets lake, stream, and small saltwater fish with ease. Satin finished stainless steel flat ground 6" blade. Overall length 11". Molded leather sheath.



NO. W769 SUPER FILLET
—Long, flexible blade for filleting large saltwater and freshwater fish. Satin finished stainless steel flat ground 9" blade. Overall length 14". Leather sleeve for storing only.



AXE KNIFE COMBINATION

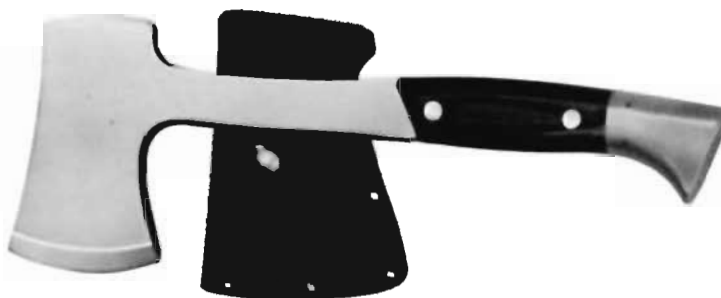
NO. W6610

— A compact outfit light enough to be carried on the belt. Carbon steel axe-knife combination with matched, resin impregnated hardwood handles. Knife has saber ground 4½" blade. Axe has 2¾" cutting edge and overall length of 11". Leather sheath is made as one unit with belt slot. Axe alone weighs one lb. Combination set packaged in box that can be folded into self display unit.



BELT AXE

NO. W10 LIGHTWEIGHT AXE— Carbon steel axe with 2¾" cutting edge. Resin impregnated hardwood handle. Overall length 11". Leather belt sheath with belt slot. Axe weighs one lb.

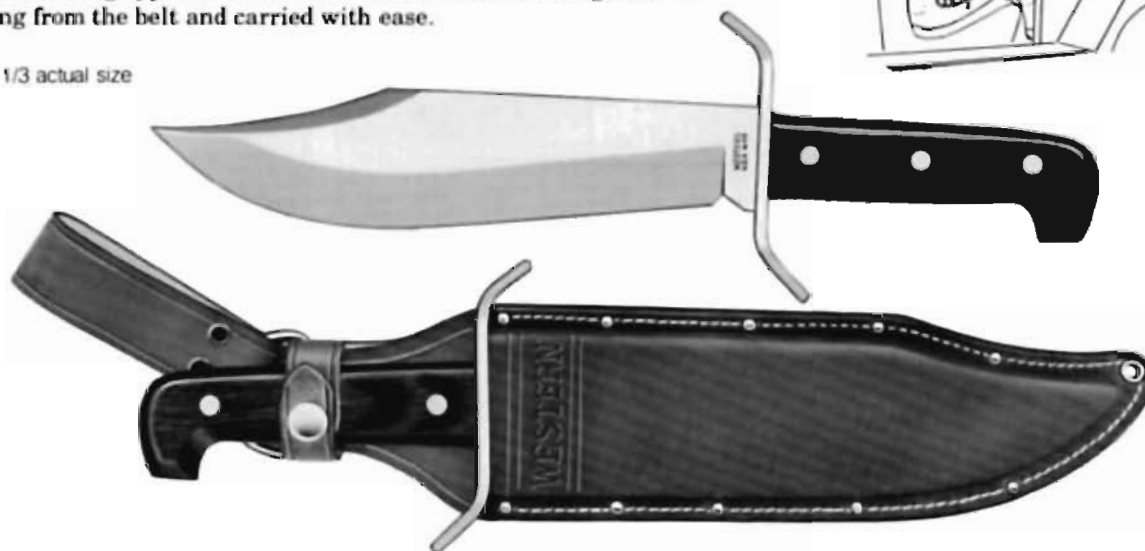


WESTERN BOWIE KNIFE

NO. W49—This large knife conforms to the classic style of the original Bowie knives. Heavy gauge 9½" carbon steel blade with brass guard and resin impregnated hardwood handle. Full width steel tang extends through entire handle. Overall length 14½". Exclusive swing-type molded leather sheath allows this big knife to be hung from the belt and carried with ease.

NO. W49W/P BOWIE KNIFE WITH TROPHY PLAQUE

Bowie Knife with hardwood plaque designed to hold knife and hang on wall. Plaque has walnut finish and measures 7" × 18". Solid brass sign plate. Complete unit, including wire for hanging, is packaged in one cardboard shipping container.

NO. 992 CERAMIC HONE

— Touch-up hone for field or home use. Sapphire hard, fine grained ceramic. Three different surfaces: flat top and bottom, rounded sides and V-groove.

Hone is 6½" x 1" x ¾".

Leather thong included.

BLADE STEELS— Western uses only the finest American made, cutlery grade, alloy steels. Stainless steel blades are made of 440A high carbon stainless steel. This alloy has excellent hardenability as well as the highest shock strength of all the 440 series stainless steels. Carbon steel blades are made of special, high carbon, chrome vanadium steel. Western carefully selects the best temperatures and treatments for each type of steel used. All blades are accurately hardened and tempered for the right combination of hardness and toughness.

PACKAGING — One color tuck-end individual boxes are standard packaging on pocket knives and sheath knives. Three color skin pack cards are available on most sheath knives and pocket knives. These are ideal for self service display. When ordering add the letter P to stock number.



COMPLETE MODERN FACTORY— Western Cutlery Co. is located on a 12-acre site in Longmont, Colorado at the foot of the Rocky Mountains. From 1911 to 1978 the business was situated in the nearby city of Boulder. In 1978, when more space was needed to meet the increasing demand for Western knives, the company constructed a larger building in Longmont and moved the entire operation to its present location. 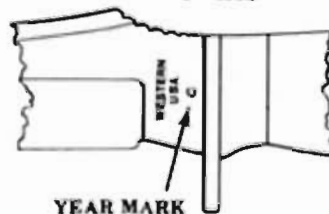
